



UTAH PHLEBOTOMY TRAINING GRANT

Candidate Application

Purpose. A limited number of grants are available for eligible Utah residents to complete OQMPS phlebotomy training in Ogden, Murray, or Orem. Classes are held for three consecutive days, either from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Grant recipients must complete the training, actively pursue employment in phlebotomy or a closely related field, and participate in follow-up regarding training and employment outcomes.

MANDATORY ELIGIBILITY: You must currently live in Utah, be currently unemployed, and have reliable transportation to class each day. Submitting an application does not guarantee selection or funding.
